The courses on the right will be considered for transfer credit based on comparability of content and level, with a grade earned of “C” or higher. For the credits to be awarded, students must provide an official transcript sent directly to Vista College from the prior educational institution(s). The course(s) must have been completed no more than seven years prior, except for certain General Education courses. The transcript must be from a college or university that was accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Students may transfer up to 75% of the total credits in the program.
